## PROTECTING YOUR RIGHTS TO PRIVACY

In a pluralistic and diverse society such as ours, what ties us together as Americans are shared ideals of political community. The core of these ideals, and our system of government, is the United States Constitution. That document, originally written in 1787, established a blueprint of government still in place today. The Constitution organizes the federal government as three co-equal branches: legislative, executive and judicial. Through its provision in Article V, it establishes a process whereby the document can be formally amended, thus, responsive to the will of "we the people."

Thanks to a process for amendment and the power of judicial review, our Constitution is not static. Nor is it inherently self-sustaining. Its survival depends upon each generation of Americans understanding, supporting and actively championing its principles and values.
